Abstract submission guidelines

- Abstract must be clear and specific by highlighting the key findings.
- Must provide a clear scientific justification for your work, and indicate possible applications and extensions.
- Do NOT repeat the Abstract, or just list experimental results.
- The word limitations for the abstract is 250-350 words.
- Duplicate abstracts will be rejected.
- The structure of the abstract should follow the below order.
 1. Title
 2. Author and Affiliation
 3. Abstract
- Once, the abstract is received in proper format, it will undergo peer review process by the scientific committee members.
- Only if the submitted abstracts fulfill the SCM peer review criteria, those abstracts will be accepted and considered for oral and poster presentations.
- **Based on the interest of participant, we request them to send the full-length abstract with respect to journal's publishing format for publications.**

Scientific Committee Members peer review criteria for abstract review.

Abstract review criteria (maximum score 100):

1. Substantial results indicating that work has been or is nearly completed = (20).
2. Innovative information, or presents a new topic or application in the field of interest = (20).
3. Significant contribution to the field, and the development of global knowledge= (20).
4. Background of issues = (10).
5. Objectives of presentation = (10).
6. Concise and coherent = (10).
7. Focus and relevance to an international audience = (10).
